RCM Report

Greetings Family,

Your RCM team attended region, January 10 & 11, 2026 at Stoney Creek, 2601 South Providence Road, Columbia, MO. There are 2 motions that will need your group votes.

They are as follows:

Motion 20260110-1: To increase the PR budget to include an additional amount for webmaster to travel to region and be available for assistance during region for the areas, which will be \$1,100.00 per budget year, increasing the PR budget to \$12,346.00.

Intent: To allow better access to areas to get help with all items concerning websites, phonline, and updates to BMLT in house and ensure quicker completion and assistance.

Motion 20260110-2: To change guidelines 6.1A from "...which require tax records for five (5) years prior to the current tax year to be on hand. "To state.... "which require tax records for seven (7) years prior to the current tax year to be on hand."

Intent: To follow legal standards for financial record keeping.

Please bring your group votes back to the March ASC. If you have any concerns about these motions, see your RCM team.

Campvention chair resume passed. There were no motions to be voted on at region from the previous region (Oct 2025). The IT guidelines will be submitted at the April RSC. There was a request for an allotment of books for the home group meeting happening in Crossroads Prison. Discussed what if addict taking in meeting is no longer available. Also discussed using literature budget to help facilitate literature request. Next workshop will be 11th Concept-Money Flow at the April RSC. Next RSC will be April 18-19, 2026 at Stoney Creek (see above address). All are welcome to attend.
